Hygiene and safety measures

Junior European Championships June 28 – July 4, 2021 (Competition days)

The German Wrestling Federation (Deutscher Ringer-Bund - DRB) has, in collaboration with the Medical Commission of the world wrestling federation United World Wrestling (UWW), developed a sophisticated concept of hygiene and safety measures for the Junior European Championships in Dortmund, Germany.

The concept of the so-called “bubble” system was applied previously during several competitions and events on an international stage.

Experiences from hygiene and safety measures of previous events in Dortmund, such as the Figure Skating Trophy (December 2020), PSD Indoor Meeting and the German Athletics Championships (February 2021) will be taken into account. Also experience for future events such as the “Finals2021”.

The competition center will be the “Helmut-Körnig-Halle”. Participants and volunteers will be accommodated in hotels within walking distance to the competition center.

The general hygiene and safety measures (physical distance, face masks, no handshake, cough and sneeze etiquette, disinfection, etc.) will be adhered.

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused a general danger around the world, spreading with high speed, and causing great consequences for the health of the population, human casualties and great economic problems. Unfortunately, apart from vaccination and measures of physical distance with the use of face masks, at the moment, there is no effective cure. In this situation, life must not stop, not even sport events. This is the reason why a way should be found to reduce this danger to a minimum and protect the health and life of athletes and other participants in competitions and outside.

UWW organized the Individual World Cup for seniors in December 2020 in Belgrade and the Olympic qualifying tournament in Budapest and Sofia in March and May 2021 for the Olympic Games in Tokyo. The preventive medical measures implemented at these events proved to be successful and they prevented the entry of infected people into the events. These individuals would be potential vectors of infection and might lead to major problems.

The events were held in the so-called “bubble” system without any audience, which means that all individuals participating at the competitions: athletes, coaches, masseurs, medical staff, team management, guests, organizers and volunteers were accommodated in appropriate hotels and worked in isolation for the entire duration of the competition without any contact with other individuals of unknown COVID-19 status.

1. They were accommodated in hotels exclusively arranged for the events and did not welcome any guests.
2. They were transported by vehicles rented exclusively for the event.
3. Their movement was restricted to transport from the airport to the registration center and from the hotel to the competition center and vice versa.
4. They were not allowed to leave the “bubble” at any time.
5. Any violation of these measures causes automatic disqualification.

In order to successfully organize this event without any consequences for the health and life of all participants, it is necessary to adhere to the following procedures:

- All participants must properly wear an appropriate face mask at all times, except during meals.
- Only athletes are exempt from wearing a face mask during the fights.

1. Obligations of the national selection management

- All event participants must have a valid negative PCR test on SARS-CoV-2 not older than 72 hours before arriving at the competition center. Certificates of a negative PCR test will be accepted in German and/or English.
- All athletes must provide a medical certificate confirming they are healthy and fit to compete. The medical examination must be done no more than 14 days before the start of the competition. In addition to the domestic language, the certificate must be translated into English, signed and certified by a medical doctor.
- All participants must sign an Honor Pledge declaring they have no symptoms that could indicate a COVID-19 infection nor that they have been in contact with infected individuals in the last two weeks.

Attachment 1: Honor Pledge

The three documents shall be provided in person at the registration (PCR-certificate, medical certificate and Honor Pledge)

- All participants must be provided with appropriate face masks and adhere to measures of physical distance such as: physical distance of 2 meters between individuals and avoiding handshakes.
- The organizer provides a sufficient amount of quality face masks that will be changed at least twice a day.
- The team leader will measure the body temperature of all members of the delegation on a daily basis at around 7h00 and 21h00. Results must be recorded on a special form. The completed forms will be handed over to the representative of the event organizer every evening.

Attachment 2: Form body temperature

In case any of the members of the delegation have problems that would indicate a COVID-19 infection, it is necessary to immediately inform the leader of the medical team, who will take the necessary medical and epidemiological measures.

In case of any problem with the participants that may raise the suspicion of COVID-19 infection, the team leader will immediately report to the event organizer, who shall arrange the examination by a medical doctor.

2. Obligations of the event organizer

The event organizer is obliged to provide an adequate registration center where a rapid antigen test will be performed immediately upon arrival of the participants. Adequate space must be provided for participants ensuring a 2m distance between individuals until the receipt of a negative test result. Not till then participants or heads of delegations are allowed to enter the accreditation center.

This so-called “rapid test center” will be located in the new foyer of the Helmut-Körnig-Halle. Access will be at the south side of the competition center.

Individuals tested positive for the COVID-19 antigen test shall be referred to isolation in special rooms at the hotel. Further medical procedures shall then be undertaken.

Upon completion of registration, the participants shall be transported to the hotel by special assigned vehicles or walk to their hotels if located within walking distance to the competition center. The hotels shall be predominantly booked exclusively for the participants. Each hotel has its own hygiene and safety measures. All participants shall be accommodated in single or double rooms. Any change or relocation to other rooms is prohibited.

Each hotel must provide special (quarantine) rooms for the accommodation of unwell participants, relating to the measure of isolation and self-isolation.

Meals for participants shall be provided in the hotel restaurant and/or in the Congress Center of the Westfalenhallen Dortmund. It is mandatory to wear a face mask at all times except during meals. Meals shall be organized according to the self-service system. Tables and chairs must be arranged in such a way as to maintain physical distance. The hotel must provide sufficient means for hand disinfection before and after meals. The hotel must provide food that meets the hygienic, religious and nutritional needs of the athletes.

All participants are not allowed to leave the hotel for a walk, shopping, etc. Any unallowed leave shall be considered a serious violation of discipline and shall result in the exclusion from the event.

The organizer will provide a sufficient amount of drinking water for the participants at the competition center.



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3. Transport of participants

Participants will be transported in special vehicles. Ventilation and disinfections will be done daily before and after the transports. Only accredited participants of the Junior European Championships get access to official transport. Face masks are obligatory. The number of passengers per vehicle is determined by the national regulations for public transport at that time.

4. Registration

Participants will get their registrations at an appropriate registration center according to a determined schedule. The registration center has to be large enough to ensure the following:

- Physical distance
- Marks on the ground
- Sanitary products for hand disinfection
- Additional quantities of face masks
- Appropriate sanitary facilities
- A bin with lid for used masks

The organizer ensures that only members from one national selection will be present at the registration center at a time. Everybody involved in the registration process is obliged to act in accordance with the hygiene and safety measures, including the use of face masks and appropriate hand hygiene.

5. Accommodation

All participants will be accommodated in appropriate hotel rooms supplied with adequate hygiene and disinfection equipment. The organizer will accommodate the participants in single or double rooms only. A change of the hotel room after the beginning of the competitions is not allowed.

Sanitary products for hand disinfection have to be placed at the entrance to the hotel restaurants. Meals have to be prepared in accordance with the physical, religious and other needs of the participants, as it is ruled in the UWW regulations. Meals have to be consumed in large dining rooms according to a fixed schedule. Designated time for the meals will be 30 minutes.

If a Head of Delegation of a national federation needs to hold a meeting with the team, it is necessary to arrange with the hotel reception for the exact time of the meeting. Meetings have to take place in special designated meeting rooms only.



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6. Training

The training process shall take place according to the plan of the National Selections in specially assigned premises in the competition center. Disinfection shall be performed before and after the training. Only athletes, their coaches, and accompanying medical staff can enter and use the mat. Before entering the mat, participants must pass the appropriate disinfection barrier for shoes and hands which will be placed at the entrance to the training facilities.

Showers – personal hygiene of each athlete will be performed in the hotel rooms.

Trainings will take place according to the established schedule, which will be delivered to each national selection.

On the day of the competition, training and warm-up will be performed in the competition center. Each national selection shall have its own temporary locker room. The locker room shall be disinfected daily. The size of the locker room is adjusted to the number of athletes per team. When going from the locker room to the mat, athletes must cross a disinfection barrier before entering the mat.

7. Medical examination of competitors before measurement

The medical examination of the competitors before the measurement is performed by specific medical personnel separately for each category scheduled for the fights on that day.

In addition to the examination prescribed by the UWW regulations, body temperature is also measured. An athlete who has an elevated temperature above 37.5°C is separated and after 15 to 20 minutes the body temperature is measured again. In case the temperature is still above 37.5°C, the athlete shall be excluded from the competition and sent to the COVID-19 outpatient unit.

8. Medical care

Medical care is performed according to the UWW Medical Security Regulations. One medical doctor and several medical technicians will be present at the mats. During the competitions, one orthopedist with the necessary equipment for possible immobilization will be present.

Each medical worker will wear a face mask and disposable gloves when providing help to the athletes.

One ambulance vehicle shall be parked in front of the competition center which will transport injured athletes to the appropriate medical institutions, if necessary.



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A special outpatient unit for the examination of participants with suspected infection of COVID-19 shall be located separately from the other rooms and specially marked. Here, if necessary, samples shall be taken for appropriate analyses in order to verify the nature of the problem and decide on referral to other competent infectious disease institutions. The organizer may refer these patients to the selected COVID-19 outpatient unit for additional diagnostic procedures. A PCR test will be performed in each suspected case of infection.

9. Mat hygiene

Before entering the mat, all athletes have to (1) pass the disinfection barrier for footwear, (2) use the material for drying the shoes, and (3) disinfect their hands.

The mat has to be cleaned and disinfected before and after the competition. For the disinfection of the mat only those disinfectants should be used, that do not irritate the skin and/or the mucosa.

10. Referees

Referees, as all other participants, have to follow all preventive medical measures.

Referees are not allowed to touch athletes at any time. There will be no handshake between referees and athletes. The athlete shall bow to the referee. The winner will be announced by hand signal. The chief referee should only invite for consultation only if necessary.

Referee sets are inspected without touching. Physical distance must be maintained between the judge and the timekeeper. It is necessary to disinfect the hands with a suitable agent. The point indicators must be disinfected after use.

11. Anti-Doping

Doping controls have to be performed in accordance with the regulations of WADA. Doping control stations have to make sure that athletes could keep enough physical distance from each other. Face masks are obligatory.



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12. Code of conduct

It is necessary to adhere to basic preventive medical measures such as physical distance, wearing clean face masks and hand disinfection. Contact between participants in the competition should be reduced to avoiding physical contact and preventive medical measures must be adhered. Depending on the epidemiological situation and national and regional regulations in that time, there might be rules that will be communicated to the participants in written form (German/English).

13. Acces to the competition center

An external security service shall check the body temperature of all individuals, who want to access the competition center. An individual, who has an elevated body temperature above 37.5 °C is separated and after 15 to 20 minutes the body temperature is measured again. In case the body temperature is still above 37.5°C, the individual is denied access to the competition center and sent to the COVID-19 outpatient unit.

For the documentation of the body temperature measurement, each individual will get a coloured sticker on the accreditation (every day has its own colour).

Generally, sanitary products for hand disinfection will be placed at the entrance to the competition center as well as all important accesses inside the competition center.

14. Control PCR test for COVID-19

A control PCR test for COVID-19 may be performed at the end of the competition for each team the day before they leave the country. All national teams shall receive their results within 24 hours.

These tests shall apply to those selections whose countries require a negative PCR test as a condition for return to the country without imposing quarantine measures. The payment will be by the participants, while the price of PCR testing is (*1) ___ Euro.

*1 = prices for PCR testing is not known yet



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15. Award Ceremony

Medals will be awarded on a special podium by UWW officials. In doing so, they will not shake hands with the medal holders or each other. Congratulations shall be performed with a bow and verbally

Medals, plaques and other awards will be presented on special trays by hostesses.

Physical contact between the athletes during the medal ceremony is prohibited. All participants have to act in accordance with the hygiene and safety measures at all times.

16. Obligation of the organizer

The organizer is obliged to provide for all participants in the organization of the event who have contact with athletes or other members of the national teams to be tested negative for COVID-19. Exceptions derive from the current national and regional regulations such as for vaccinated individuals.

The organizer shall implement all available measures to prevent the transmission of the infection from hired staff to the participants of the event.

For event staff, who come into direct or indirect contact with participants the following measures shall be applied:

- Providing sufficient quantities of personal protection equipment and disinfectants
- Education of all employees on the application of preventive measures
- Daily control of the application of preventive measures, including daily control of body temperature before work

LIABILITY RELEASE WAIVER

The World Health Organization has declared the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) a worldwide pandemic. Due to its capacity to transmit from person-to-person through respiratory droplets, the UWW and the Organizing Committee ("OC") have set recommendations, guidelines, and some prohibitions throughout the Sanitary Protocol and the adjustments to the UWW International Wrestling Rules in this regard for official competitions on the UWW Calendar (the "Event") and training camps organized in conjunction with such official competition.

3. And, following the pronouncements above I hereby declare the following:
 - I am fully and personally responsible for my own safety and actions while and during my participation and I recognize that I may be in any case be at risk of contracting COVID-19.
 - With full knowledge of the risks involved, I hereby release, waive, discharge the UWW and the OC, from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death, that may be sustained by me related to COVID-19 while participating in the Event while in, on, or around the premises or while using the facilities that may lead to unintentional exposure or harm due to COVID-19 .

By signing below I acknowledge that I have read the foregoing Liability Release Waiver and understand its contents; that I am at least eighteen (18) years old and fully competent to give my consent; That I have been sufficiently informed of the risks involved and give my voluntary consent in signing it as my own free act and deed; with full intention to be bound by the same, and free from any inducement or representation.
