SANITARY PROTOCOL for the CADET WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Budapest, 19-25 July 2021

There is still a worldwide pandemic of Novel Coronavirus (**COVID-19**), which is a contagious respiratory and vascular (blood vessel) disease. It was discovered in December 2019 and caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (**SARS-CoV-2**), which is a specific type of coronavirus. After more than 170 million reported cases of COVID-19 worldwide, there are still many unknown and unanswered question regarding this viral disease. Around four in five infected individuals do not develop any symptoms or they experienced only mild illness.

Longer-term damage to organs (in particular, the lungs and heart) has been observed, and there is concern about a significant number of patients who have recovered from the acute phase of the disease but continue to experience a range of effects months afterwards.

The standard method of diagnosis is by real-time reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction (RRT-PCR) from a nasopharyngeal swab. Antigen tests (preferably Siemens) should be used as rapid detection (15 min), but only for orientation and results will be recorded accordingly. Recommended measures to prevent infection include frequent social distancing, quarantine, covering coughs and sneezes, hand washing, and keeping unwashed hands away from the face. The use of face masks or cloth face coverings is recommended in public settings to minimise the risk of transmissions.

I. Known Facts regarding COVID-19:

- 1. Coronaviruses can be transmitted between animals and humans.
- 2. Typical symptoms of COVID-19 include running nose, cough, fever, fatigue, breathing difficulties (i.e. shortness of breath), loss of smell and taste;
- 3. In many people, especially children, who are infected with COVID-19, the symptoms are not severe, and patients can be managed without hospital care.
- 4. In more severe cases, the virus can cause pneumonia, Severe Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome, Organ Failure, and even death.
- 5. This disease is highly contagious, and it is very likely transmitted by droplet infection (i.e. being in proximity to an infected person, who coughs or sneezes), or touching surfaces or objects, which are in the environment of the infected person;
- II. What can be done to lower your risk of becoming infected with COVID-19?
- 1. Avoid close contact with people who have or appear to have an Acute Respiratory Illness.
- 2. If you are experiencing symptoms of an upper respiratory infection, **practice "cough etiquette"** (i.e. maintain distance from others, cover coughs and sneezes with a hand, flexed elbow or disposable tissue). Request others in your company to do the same.
- 3. **Wash your hands frequently** with either an alcohol-based gel or soap and water, especially after direct contact with ill people or their environment.
- 4. Wear disposable nonsterile gloves when touching potentially infectious materials.
- 5. The use of face masks.



- 6. Patients, who experience upper respiratory symptoms, and then they develop any kind of respiratory difficulty (i.e., shortness of breath, chest pain etc.) are strongly advised to seek immediate, or very prompt, medical evaluation and treatment.
- III. Sanitary measures," bubble", restrictions, expenses, COVID-19 certificate and Parental and Medical Authorization form, epidemiological questionnaire, responsibility, liability, and obligations during the Cadet World Championship Budapest 2021
- III.A. Summary of sanitary measures by UWW for LOC (Local Organizing Committee):
- 1. All participants shall present at accreditation a certificate of negative PCR test of less than 72 hours.
- 2. If, for any reason such document cannot be produced on arrival by any participant (e.g., a negative test result dates back for more than 3 days because of a long travel to Hungary), the LOC will provide PCR test with result within 12 hours; There will be 80 € charged per each. Upon request of a faster test, we charge extra money for a result in appr. 3 hours.
- 3. All participants must have an Ag test at accreditation realized by the LOC. Result will be ready in appr. 15 minutes.
- 4. In case of having any kind of positive test, it is strongly advised to have a filled COVID-19 Certificate Form.
- 5. **In case of any positive test**, immediate isolation measures, a dedicated place for such and treatment will be provided and covered until recovery.
- 6. In such case, epidemiological investigations will be initiated, in line with the WHO and Organizing country's (Hungary) guidelines to ensure no other participant(s) is infected.
- 7. There will be a dedicated Hotel with an isolated floor for observation only for those participants in the championships who produce positive sample.
- 8. Sanitizers and masks will be provided by the LOC during the championship.
- 9. All places (transports, hotels, training place, competition hall, etc.) will be carefully disinfected several times per day.
- 10. Competition mats will be disinfected regularly, and every competitor will pass a disinfection barrier when entering the field of play; shoes will be wiped.
- 11. The LOC Medical team will consist of regular doctors for competition injuries, and a dedicated team for all aspects linked to COVID-19.
- 12. PCR tests and results before departure for all participants are planned so that no one is placed in isolation in their country upon return. Upon request it will be done and there will be 80 € charged per each for a 12-hours and extra money for a 3-hours result.
- III.B. For all these measures to be efficient, the collaboration of all will be required, namely:
- 1. The LOC create the so-called **Hungarian Wrestling "bubble"** (Hotel, transportation, Wrestling Hall).
- 2. All participants obliged to stay in this bubble. In case of leaving, the participant must be disclosed.



- 3. It is also strongly advised to fill Parental Approval form for those who correspond to that age.
- 4. All participants must fill a questionnaire, temperature check sheet and a liability release waiver upon arrival at the registration / accreditation. The temperature check sheet will remain at the Team leader who must present a filled and signed one in case of any medical problem.
- 5. **Liability:** all participants and their representative (trainer, parent) must understand and sign that they release, waive, discharge the UWW and the Hungarian Wrestling Federation, from all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly, or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death, that may be sustained by the participant related to COVID-19 while participating in the Cadet World Championship Budapest 2021 while in, on, or around the premises or while using the facilities that may lead to unintentional exposure or harm due to COVID-19.
- 6. All the medical expenses related to COVID-19:
 - a. **For licensees** are explained on the following link: https://unitedworldwrestling.org/governance/accidentillness-insurance-emergency
 - For all participants not licensed by UWW all the expenses related to COVID-19 issue (tests, treatments, isolation, quarantine, hospital, etc) must be covered by the Federation of the participant.
- 7. Social distancing, hand sanitizing and the wearing of a mask will be requested from all participants.
- 8. Mats (warm-up area & competition) should be cleaned and disinfected before and after every session.
- 9. Doctors carrying out the daily medical examination should remain vigilant to any symptom as described by the WHO.
- 10. In case an Athlete shows a temperature he/she will be eliminated from the competition. Further investigation and monitoring will be started by the Medical Team and additional measures can be taken.
- 11. The Local Medical Team could measure SO% and Heart Rate in case of any doubt and document it without obligation upon a "bad result" to disqualify the competitor. In case of a dangerous values the further steps should be implemented by the general Medical Regulation by the UWW.
- 12. The UWW Medical Commission and the Local Authorities have the right to overwrite any part of these instructions based on the future situation.
- 13. Respect of all instructions required later by the LOC.
- 14. In case of a person holding vaccination certificate, the above-mentioned PCR and antigen test results are still compulsory for each participant.

III.C. Obligatory restrictions by the LOC and by the UWW

Based on the existing Hungarian legislation, UWW regulations and recommendations regarding COVID-19 infection, the organizer will apply the following obligatory restrictions to run a safe and risk-free European Olympic Qualification tournament in Budapest.

1. WHAT TO DO before competition

• All participants shall present upon arrival at the customs and later at the accreditation the abovementioned certificate of negative PCR test of less than 72 hours.



- 10-14 days prior to competition a medical certificate should be issued to all athletes, including the upper respiratory situation of the wrestler, which should be presented during accreditation and during the daily medical check.
- COVID-19 Certificate, Parental and Medical Authorization form shall be filled by the team doctor and the parents of the competitor before entering to Hungary.
- **Epidemiological Questionnaire** must be filled for everyone including referees, coaches, leaders, and crew, during the accreditation (see attached).
- **Temperature check sheet** will stay with the team leader and should be present in case of any medical problem.
- A Liability Release Waiver must be signed by the representative (trainer, parent) of the competitor or being grown up (trainer, referee, staff) by the accredited person.
- Please NOTE that the accreditation card will ONLY be given to persons with a signed epidemiological questionnaire, temperature check sheet and Liability Release Waiver.
- Only accredited persons will be allowed to enter in the venue.
- Spectators shall be entered. Adults with a vaccination certificate or with an immunity card or in case of a minor (child less than 18 years) accompanied by an adult with the above criteria.

2. WHAT TO DO during competition

- **Before entering to the competition hall**, the temperature and the proper use of facemask of all participants will be monitored.
- For everyone who is fine to enter, a different coloured sticker will be placed on his/her accreditation card. Without a valid sticker the security guards will have the right to escort the person from the venue.
- **Daily OBLIGATORY Medical Check** with special focus on upper respiratory infection, symptoms and temperature for those who enter the field of play.
- Anyone who is unwell and experiencing respiratory symptoms should contact the COVID- team.

3. HYGIENIC RESTRICTIONS

- Organizers will provide plastic shoe defender to all athletes, which must be worn before entering the Field of Play.
- Before stepping on the mat, all athletes and referees must use a special shoe disinfectant unit, placed next to each mat.
- All athletes and referees must use hand disinfectant tissue, before and after each bout.
- Mats (warm-up area & competition) will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- Every participant, including the referees and medical staff in the mats, but except the competitors wrestling in the mat must wear face masks.
- Skin and surface disinfectant spray will be provided for every team during the accreditation.
- Special medical room will be available for COVID team and in case of possible isolation.



4. CONSEQUENCES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

- Any wrestler or other participant taking part in the competition is deemed to adhere and comply with all the measures (and their consequences) put in place to protect the health of all participants.
- Any refusal to comply, tampering or dissimulating any information about the health of an athlete or other participant will sanctioned accordingly. UWW reserves the right to bring civil or criminal proceedings against any participant at fraud with the sanitary protocols in place.

It is the top priority of the Organizing Committee and United World Wrestling to keep everyone safe and healthy, therefore Organizers will be in close contact with the local authorities and comply with all the rules and regulations and ask everyone for a full cooperation.

We are very grateful for any suggestions or different opinions, which would contribute to the safety of the participants' health and the success of the championship.

Every team leader must check the actual governmental restrictions and situation upon entry to Hungary and returning home.

INFORMATION FOR SPECTATORS

According to the Hungarian National Center for Public Health, spectators are welcome on the Cadet World Championships in Budapest. **Compliance with the following rules is a condition of participation:**

- Spectators will be able to follow the Cadet World Championships at Tüskecsarnok,
 Budapest with a negative, not older than 72 hours PCR test result.
- There is no entry fee for the competition.
- Spectators will receive a paper armband with a date upon entry.
- From 1st July, Hungary, like the other Member States, will provide free entry to
 foreigners arriving with an EU COVID certificate, but with certain restrictions for Sport
 Events. For them to be able to enter the event, only the required PCR test is needed.
 Their armband is valid during the whole competition.
- If someone will stay longer than 3 days, without an EU COVID certificate, she/he must undergo another PCR test on site (EUR 80). Their armband will be valid only for 3 days.
- Security will request to show the EU COVID certificate at the entrance.
- Distancing of 1 meter and separating from participants (athletes, coaches and staff of the Field of Play) are still obligatory!
