This invitation is being provided under the sporting principles of the international wrestling federation United World Wrestling in an effort of camaraderie and exchange of knowledge as is commonly done throughout the World.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen!

On November 14-19, 2021, the World Pankration Championship is taking place in Kharkiv, Ukraine. The competitions are held according to the unified calendar plan of sports events of the international wrestling federation United World Wrestling and Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine. The organizer of the competition is the All-Ukrainian Pankration Federation - the official national member body of the United World Wrestling International Federation.

Person(s)/ the group showing this letter is part of the World Pankration Championship 2021, Kharkiv.

Participating countries teams will be arriving few days prior to the event. Together with the international wrestling federation United World Wrestling All-Ukrainian Pankration Federation is making sure that all the COVID-19 protocols are being followed by the participants.

Please note that All foreign citizens regardless of the country of arrival to enter Ukraine must have a policy (certificate) of insurance issued by an insurance company registered (operating) in Ukraine, and covers the costs related to the treatment of COVID-19, observation, and is valid for the entire period of stay in Ukraine. (https://visitukraine.today/)

All foreign citizens, holders of a temporary residence permit, as well as stateless persons, need to have one of the following documents:

- a document confirming the receipt of a full course of vaccination against COVID-19 with vaccines included by WHO in the list of approved for use in emergencies; or
- a negative rapid test for the SARS-CoV-2 antigen (RAT, Ag) that was done no more than 72 hours before entry; or
- a certificate of a negative PCR test result done no more than 72 hours before the entry.

With this letter, the All-Ukrainian Pankration also asks for help in the rapid passage of border passports and customs control.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

PARTICIPATION

- 1. Only the National Federations or Committees duly affiliated to UWW for the year 2021 can participate in the event. They are fully responsible for entering their athletes within the deadline.
- 2. National Federations or Committees can enter a maximum of 2 athletes per all weight categories. Final entries confirming the names of participants, number of nights of their staying for the accommodation package should be entered on Athena (http://athena.unitedworldwrestling.org/) before 12 November 2021.

Licenses must be purchased by October 15, 2021, on Athena (http://athena.unitedworldwrestling.org/). If you have any issue using Athena, you can contact aso@unitedworldwrestling.org.

- 3. All Athletes and Hellanodekes (Referees) are required to have the United World Wrestling License for the competition year 2021 that includes health insurance. Licenses must be purchased online by each National Federation through Athena (http://athena.unitedworldwrestling.org) at the cost of 100 CHF for Juniors & Seniors and 50 CHF for Cadets. To purchase a license online, it is required to submit a medical certificate, a copy of the passport and a digital photo of the athlete.
- 4. Each Senior competitor must be 20 years old or older. Competitors aged 18-19 years old (born 2003-2002) are allowed to participate in senior division upon presentation of a medical certificate.
- 5. Each Junior competitor must be 18-19 years old (born 2003-2002). 17 years old athlete is allowed to compete in the Junior category with a medical and a parental certificate.
- 6. Each Cadet competitor must be 16-17 years old (born 2005-2004). 15 years old athlete is allowed to compete in the Junior category with a medical and a parental certificate.
- 7. Each contestant deemed to be taking part of his/her owns free will, responsible for him/her, shall be allowed to compete in only one weight category: the one corresponding to his weight at the time of the official weighin.
- 8. The preliminary entries (number of participants) must be sent to UKR3@unitedworldwrestling.org before 01 October 2021.
- 9. The delegations in need of a visa to enter Ukraine must send their visa application forms to before 15 September 2021.
- 10. The organizing committee is providing an accommodation package that includes accommodation in double bedroom, breakfast, lunch, dinner and transportation from/to the competition venue at fixed times. Cost of the accommodation package is 120 Euros/day per person and is to be paid at the accreditation the day of the arrival at the Official Hotel. The Competition Fee and Transport from/to Airport of Kharkiv and from Hotel from/to the Competition Venue are included in the Accommodation Package. The bank details to pay in advance are to be requested from the organizer UKR3@unitedworldwrestling.org. Note: the minimum stay for the accommodation package is 3 nights.
- 11. The organizer will take care of booking the rooms for the delegations benefiting from the accommodation package.
- 12. The delegation who will not take any accommodation package might have to find their own accommodation and arrange their own transportation.
- 13. The participation fee for the athletes who will not buy the package is:

Pankration Athlima or Pankration : 60,00 Euros
Pankration Athlima + Pankration : 90,00 Euros
Pankration Athlima + Palaesmata + Polydamas : 90,00 Euros
Pankration + Palaesmata + Polydamas : 90,00 Euros
Palaesmata + Polydamas : 50,00 Euros
Pankration Athlima+Pankration+Palesmata+Polydamas : 100,00 Euros

payable in cash at accreditation to the organizer.

- 14. The delegations will be welcomed by the organizing Committee upon their arrival in Kharkiv International Airport and will be driven to the hotel to proceed with accreditation.
- 15. Competitors are under the exclusive responsibility of their National Federation or Committee through their respective coaches. Any breach of the rules will be sanctioned according to the UWW Disciplinary Regulations.

TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The competition will be run according to the UWW Pankration official rules on 3 UWW approved mats.
- 2. The competition will take place in the official weight categories and no weight allowance will be accepted:

Cadets: 16-17 years old (from 15 with medical and parental certificate)

➤ Men: 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, +75kg.

➤ Women: 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, +70kg

Juniors: 18-19 years old (from 17 with medical and parental certificate)

➤ Men: 60, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92, 100, +100 kg.

➤ Women: 50, 53, 57, 61, 65, 70, 75, +75kg

Seniors: 20 years and older 20-35 years old (from 19 with medical and parental certificate)

➤ Men: 60, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92,100, +100 kg.

➤ Women: 50, 53, 57, 61, 65, 70, 75, +75kg

- 3. Each competitor will be requested to undergo a medical examination before the official weigh-in, during which his/her must be provided with an international medical certificate of identity document.
- 4. The drawing of lots for position in the brackets will be done by the competition software automatically.
- 5. Competitors who forfeit a match without proper medical report will not be allowed to proceed throughout the tournament (even in other styles) and will be withdrawn from the final ranking.
- 6. The UWW license covers medical assistance to the competitors in the event of an accident occurring during the competition. If a competitor wishes to have a medical examination or receive a treatment that is not linked to an accident that happened during the competition, either he/she or his/her National Federation will be entitled to bear the related costs.
- 7. Each competitor will be required to wear the UWW/WPAC approved competition uniform complying with the international regulations.
- 8. Individual prizes will be given to each weight category:

1st place: 1 gold medal, certificate

2nd place: 1 silver medal, certificate

3rd place: 1 bronze medal, certificates

All participants: certificates

- 9. The first three teams in all age groups in each style will receive a cup.
- 10. The organizer will conduct random anti-doping test among the gold medalists. The categories concerned will be selected and publicly announced at the end of the weigh-in. The laboratory will analyse these tests with IOC/WADA approved. The procedure for undertaking the tests and transporting the samples to the laboratory is laid down in the UWW Regulations and in WADA's Anti-Doping Code.

HELLANODEKES (REFEREES)

- 1. Each delegation participating with more than 3 athletes (all styles combined) is required to enter at least 1 Hellanodekes (referee) of the highest category available in the country. over 15 athletes 2 (two) referees, over 30 athletes at least 3 Hellanodekes.
- 2. Countries with registered Hellanodekes who will not be present, will pay a penalty of CHF 500 during the accreditation.
- 3. Hellanodekes will be appointed by the Head of Hellanodekes from the UWW official list at the cost of the national federations.
- 4. Hellanodekes must wear the provided Endyma (uniform) during competition that is: official black polo shirt, black pants and black shoes (black plimsolls or socks, sport shoes are no longer accepted). Polo shirt can be purchased on the spot.

SANITARY PROTOCOL

World Pankration Championships Cadets, Juniors and Senior 14-19 November 2021 Kharkiv, Ukraine

The health protection measures for all wrestling championships that take place under the auspices of the UWW are planned and implemented in accordance with the provisions of the Medical Regulations of the UWW. The COVID-19 pandemic, in addition to the usual measures, also imposes the need for new measures and activities.

During the championship all safety rules will be applied with the recommendation and sanitary protocol confirmed of the Government of Ukraine.

Wearing the masks is obligatory in public area.

1. Accreditation.

All participants shall present at accreditation a certificate of negative PCR test to SARS-CoV-2 not older than 72 hours at the time of entry into the Ukraine.

The organizer on their expenses will conduct antigen rapid test before the accreditation immediately upon arrival. Upon receiving a negative test result, participants shall be referred to an accreditation point.

Participants tested positive for the rapid antigen test, shall be isolated in separate rooms, and additionally tested for SARS-CoV-2 using PCR test on cost of his/her National Federation (the price of PCR test is EUR 80). A positive result leads to disqualification from the competitions.

2. Transport & accommodation

The participants shall be accommodated in the hotels approved by the Organizer even they found their own locations and obligated to:

The temperature control will be organized in all accommodation locations.

Transport will be able for all accommodation locations and shall include special vehicles intended exclusively for the participants.

The participants shall restrict their movement to getting from the hotels to competition hall and vice versa.

The hotels are obliged to prepare a special place - an isolation room for each person participating in the tournament with symptoms of infection and to take appropriate epidemiological measures.

The organizer provides transport for participants from the hotel to competition venue and back in accordance with the applicable limits for means of transport in our country

Each independent violation of these measures causes automatic disqualification.

All locations (transports, hotels, training place, competition hall, etc.) will be regularly disinfected.

3. Competition area & Participants obligation

Each participant entering in the competition is obligated to:

- submit the body to control temperature,
- hand disinfected,
- pass a disinfection barrier when entering to the mat,
- 1. The competition will be held without spectators.
- 2. There are warm-up and competition area in venue. Before entering and living area participants are obliged to carry out disinfection.
- 3. The organizer is responsible for the disinfection of changing rooms and sanitary facilities.
- 4. The organizer provides protective gloves and beavers for hellanodikis.
- 5. The organizer provides hand sanitizers and face masks.
- 6. At the entrance to venue an automatic measurement of body temperature will be carried out.

4. Final provision.

For all participants (athletes, coaches, referees, staff, etc.) are forbidden to shake hands with each other.

PCR tests before departure shall be performed for those participants who will request it during accreditation for their expenses (the price of PCR test is EUR 80).
