### II. Date and Venue

### III. Participation

Delegations received the official invitations will be admitted to participate in the following composition:

#### V. Financial conditions

The travel expenses of delegations to the place of competition and back will be born by the sending National Federations. Subject to UWW Regulation the host country will bear the expenses to accommodate the teams and the UWW representatives as per requirements to organize the International competitions.

The Organizer will bear the following expenses on:

- Reception and seeing off the delegations in Krasnoyarsk;
- Meals and accommodation in a hotel (3 stars) in Krasnovarsk on 26-31 January 2022
- Local transport on the arrival & departure days of participants, sauna, training and cultural program.

The National Federation must pay CHF120 per person per day for the delegation with more members than allowed in the above table as well as for the delegation, which will stay longer.

### VI. Awarding

The Organizers guarantee to provide the cash prize fund as well as the special prizes. The winners are awarded with *Ivan Yariguin* Cup, gold medal and diploma. The prize winners are awarded with medals and diplomas **as well as cash prizes.**

### SANITARY PROTOCOL

January 15, 2022 Krasnoyarsk

Information on measures to counteract coronavirual infection (COVID-19) for participants and Organizers of XXXIII International tournament (FS,WW) of Grand Prix Ivan Yariguin hereinafter Event

### Requirements to the participants\* of the Event:

1) according to Resolution of Russian state sanitary doctor dated 18.03.2020 # 7 (in reduction dated 04.12.2021) "About insuring isolation mode with the end to preventing the spread of COVID-19" all participant, being foreign citizens, when boarding planes flying to Russia, including transit travel via Russian territory and when crossing the border of Russian Federation must have available a medical certificate (in Russian or English), confirming a negative result of polymer chain reaction method test (PCR), taken not earlier than 2 (two) calendar days before the arrival to the territory of Russian Federation;

in case of disability to present the medical certificate in Russian or English it is allowed to provide it in the official language of the state of the Organization that issued such medical certificate with translation in Russian, the validity of which certified by the Consular representative of Russia;

- 2) nationals of Russia and foreigners before arriving to Russian Federation should provide filling in a questionnaire to insure sanitary and quarantine control at the Russian state border crossing points;
  - 3) conduct the procedure of body temperature monitoring throughout all the Event;
  - 4) always wear a protective face mask (excluding athletes during training, warming-up and competing);
- 5) regularly wash hands with the gel using either an alcohol-based gel or soap and water:
  - 7) keep physical distances avoid crowds;
  - 8) sign a waiver of liability claims provided by the organizer;
- 9) sign a statement stating that they have not been in conscious contact with a COVID-19 positive person in the last 14 days or have not had the following symptoms:
- High temperature

- Shortness of breath

- Sore throat

- Pain in muscles and joints

- A dray cough

- loss of sense of smell and taste
- 10) Carefully respect all instructions and requirement set forth by the Organizer.

### **Shelf life of the PCR test for Russian citizens:**

According to sanitary and epidemiological rules SP 3.1.3597-20 "PREVENTION OF NEW CORONAVIRUS INFECTION (COVID-19)" shelf life of a negative result of polymer chain reaction method test (PCR) is 48 hours since the result of laboratory test on COVID-19 (p. 3.17 was issued by the Resolution of Russian state sanitary doctor dated 04.12.2021 # 33)

During the period of travel to the venue of the Events, participants are recommended:

### <u>During traveling to the place of organization of Event participants are recommended the following:</u>

- Use of personal respiratory protection equipment (masks, respirators), as well as gloves (if desired);
- Change of mascs should be done смену масок необходимо every 2-3 hours of constant wear, repeated use of masks is not allowed;
- One should touch the face with the hands as следует as rarely as possible;
- Mandatory use of skin antiseptics active against COVID-19, with regular frequency of hand treatment; antiseptics;
- Maintaining social distance.

### **Accreditation:**

Accreditation of participants included in official delegations will be carried out if there is a negative result of an express test for COVID-19 made before passing the commission for admission of participants.

### General organizational measures to counteract coronavirus infection for participants carrying out by the Organizer and the Venue of the Event:

- Carrying out before the Opening, as well as everyday wet cleaning on the Event facility with the use of virucidal disinfectants;
- cleaning the system of ventilation and checking the effectiveness of its work;
- ensure thermometry before admission to the site of all participants and guests, the media and staff (with mandatory removal from the workplace of persons with elevated body temperature and / or signs of an infectious disease);
- maintaining social distance at places where guests and participants of the facility gather by applying a one-and-a-half-meter marking;
- organization of the necessary number of places for the treatment of hands with skin antiseptics on the territory of the facility, including with the help of installed dispensers;
- provision of organizers and participants of the Event with personal respiratory protection equipment (disposable masks) and gloves;
- use of the ventilation system of the facility, including conference rooms, press rooms;

\*The participants of the Event in the present Protocol are athletes, coaches, referees, team leaders, team staff, team doctors and masseurs, NF officials.

- installation in conference halls, canteens, and other premises with the presence of participants of the Event, equipment for air disinfection (recirculators) allowed for use in the presence of people;
- admission of persons to the Venue of the Event in the presence of a hygienic mask;
- disinfection with a frequency of treatment every 2 hours of all rooms, contact surfaces at the Event Venue: door handles, handrails of stairs, railings, control panels in elevators, surfaces of tables, racks, office equipment, armrests of chairs, etc.;
- informing the staff, participants and visitors of the Event venue by placing text, audio/visual information on the need to comply with measures to prevent the spread of coronavirus infection on the entrance groups, in the information zones;
- restriction of entry to the territory of the facility of persons not related to the organization and holding of the Event;
- ensuring the accommodation of participants of the Event no more than 2 people in the room.

## When detecting the first signs of acute respiratory viral infections (runny nose, cough, fever: above 37C) in nonresident participants of the Event:

- inform the organizing committee and the hotel administration immediately;
- isolate yourself in the room, excluding any personal contact with anyone;
- undergo a laboratory examination for a new coronavirus infection COVID-19 by PCR;
- when detecting the presence of a positive PCR test in a participant of the Events, it is necessary:
- identify persons who have been in contact with the patient during the last 72 hours;
- these persons who were in contact with the carrier of a positive test must undergo a laboratory examination for a new coronavirus infection COVID-19 (PCR diagnosis on coronavirus RNA) and self-isolate until the COVID-19 test result is obtained.

Financial expenses in case of self-isolation of a participant for being in self-isolation with signs of a new coronavirus infection COVID-19 and persons who contacted them during the Event, before returning to their place of permanent residence, are borne by the sending organizations.

In accordance with the sanitary and epidemiological rules of SP 3.1.3597-20 "Prevention of new coronavirus infection (COVID-19)":

A person who has been in contact with a COVID-19 patient must be in isolation (in an observatory, at the place of residence) for at least 14 calendar days from the date of the last contact with a COVID-19 patient or until recovery (in case of disease development) (point 3.8).

Persons who have undergone a full course of vaccination against COVID-19 in the last six months, and persons who have had COVID-19 in the last six months, in the absence of symptoms of the disease, are not subject to isolation.
