SANITARY PROTOCOL
Senior Asian Championships
Ulaanbaatar, 19-24 April 2022

This sanitary protocol is based on the current sanitary requirements provided by the government of Mongolia against Covid - 19 as well as with UWW Guidance for Event Organizers and Participants.

The sanitary protocol aims to protect health and life of all participants in the Senior Asian Championships and to reduce the possibility of viral transmission to a minimum during this Event.

As a contact sport, wrestling is at higher risk of viral transmission so higher degree of attention and more stringent measures are required from the Wrestling community.

1. According to the latest regulations:

- **All passengers are not required to have any “COVID-19” PCR test (Antigen test/Rapid test) to enter Mongolia.**
- **Passengers are not required to be fully vaccinated.**
- **Passengers shall fill out medical declaration form upon arrival at the border checkpoints.**
- **Any "COVID-19" tests upon arrival are lifted.**
- **Passengers are not required to go under quarantine or self-isolation regime.**

For the participants in the Asian Championships:

- Upon arrival teams will get tested for rapid antigen test at the hotel. Please, note that in case of a positive result you will get tested for PCR test as well
- Provide enough protective masks for each member of the delegation.
- Wearing a mask is mandatory for all participants of the events except for training and fights.
- Each team is required to appoint their team doctor as a COVID-19 officer.
- In case of any problems with participants that may raise the suspicion of Covid-19 infection, the team leader has to immediately report to the Organizer.

2. Transportation of participants

- Transportation of participants will be done by special buses. Buses will be disinfected twice a day: after taking the competitors to the gym and after the end of daily obligations.

- Only accredited participants of the events can use the transport. Participants must wear face masks in the transport.

3. Accreditation

- Accreditation of participants will be performed at the appropriate accreditation office, according to the established schedule.
- Hand sanitizers will be provided.
- The organizer will try to have only one national team present during the accreditation.

4. Accommodation

- All participants will be accommodated in the appropriate hotel rooms.
- The diet of the competitors will be designed to meet the physical, religious and other needs as provided by UWW regulations.
- There will be hand sanitizers at the entrance to the restaurant.
- The dining tables will be arranged so that there is the necessary distance between the guests.

5. Training

- The training process will take place according to the plan of the National teams in specially designated training area.
- Accredited athletes, coaches and teams' medical staff can enter the wrestling mat.
- Before entering the wrestling mat, be sure to pass the appropriate disinfection barrier for shoes and hands. It will be placed at the entrance to the training room.

6. Medical examination of competitors

- The medical examination of the competitors will be performed by the doctors separately for each category that is planned on that day. In addition to the examination prescribed by the UWW regulations, body temperature is also measured.
- Every day before the weigh-in, the COVID-19 team officer submits a list of the health status of the team members (athletes, coaches, doctors, massage therapists, etc.).

7. Medical service

- Medical care is performed according to the UWW Medical Regulations.
- One doctor will be present at each wrestling mat.
- Each team should have the appropriate medical equipment to provide the necessary assistance.
- Each medical worker will wear an appropriate protective mask, and when providing the necessary help to the competitors, they have to wear special gloves that must be disposed of after a use.
- The resuscitation team will be located next to the field of play with all the necessary equipment for resuscitation procedures as well as the means for transporting the injured competitors to the appropriate medical institution.
- A doctor and a medical technician will be present in the ambulances located within the competition facility, who will provide the necessary medical assistance to other participants in the competition.
- In front of the competition hall, ambulances will be parked, and will transport any injured to the appropriate medical institutions if necessary.

For all participants not licensed by UWW all the expenses related to COVID-19 issue (tests, treatments, isolation, quarantine, hospital, etc.) must be covered by the Federation of the participant.

8. Hygiene of the wrestling mats

- All competitors have to pass the disinfection barrier for footwear before entering the wrestling mat, within which they will also need material for wiping shoes from moisture, as well as hand disinfection.

9. Anti-doping control

- Anti-doping control takes place according to WADA rules in cooperation with MONADA.

10. Behavior of participants during the events.

- It is necessary to adhere to basic preventive medical measures such as social distance, wearing clean masks and hand disinfection.
- Contact between participants in the competition should be reduced, except necessary ones.
- Handshakes with the opponent's coach, other participants are prohibited
- It is recommended to not leave the venue, training area and hotel.

11. PCR test

- A control PCR check on Covid-19 will be done after the end of the competition for each team.
- Teams must send the number of people who will need PCR test before leaving Mongolia.

PCR test fee:

PCR test at the end of the events before departure is 35 USD per person.
