WRESTLING COMPETITION

The Wrestling competition at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games will be held from Monday 5 August to Sunday 11 August at Champ de Mars Arena in Paris. This competition will consist of the following 18 medal events, summarised below:

A total of 288 competitors may take part in the Olympic Wrestling competition. This figure comprises 192 men and 96 women. For details of the qualification system, see the [IOC website](#).

COMPETITION FORMAT

All medal events will be run based on a direct elimination system. Competitors in each weight category will be drawn against opponents and the elimination system will be used to determine the two (2) finalists who will compete for the gold medal. Losing semifinalists will go to the bronze medal matches while a repechage contest will allow the athletes who lost to the two (2) finalists during the elimination phase a chance to compete for bronze medals.

Repechage matches will begin with the wrestlers who lost against either of the two (2) finalists (from qualification matches and up to and including semifinal losers). The two (2) winners of the repechage process will then wrestle against the semifinal losers, with the winners each awarded a bronze medal.

The two (2) losers of the bronze medal contests will be placed equal fifth.

Competition in each weight category will be over two (2) days and will take place in the following manner:

- preliminary rounds, 1/4 finals and semifinals (Day 1)
- Repechages (Day 2 – morning)
- Finals 1-2, 3-5 (Day 2 – evening)

→ Draws

Draws for each weight category will be held at Champ de Mars Arena on the day before competition in each of the respective weight category events. Team leaders will be required to attend each draw. The first draw will be held on Sunday 4 August, with all subsequent draws being held directly after the morning session, in the competition venue.

→ Medical control and weigh-ins

The weigh-in rooms and saunas will be located in the Olympic Village. Initial weigh-ins will be held on the morning of the day of each competition and will last 30 minutes. However, because competition in each weight category will be held over two (2) days, wrestlers who have qualified for finals, bronze-medal matches and repechage matches will have to undergo an additional weigh-in on the morning of their second day of competition.

One weigh-in procedure (15 minutes) will be held for athletes continuing their competition from the day before and a separate weigh-in procedure (30 minutes) will be held for those beginning competition that day.

For weigh-in days, one training venue will be opened from 6:30 to 7:30.



RULES

The Wrestling competition will be held in accordance with the editions of the following documents that are in force at the time of the Games:

In accordance with Rule 46 of the IOC Olympic Charter, UWW will be responsible for the control and direction of the Wrestling competition at Paris 2024.

→ Duration and scoring

The contests will consist of two (2) periods of three (3) minutes with a 30-second break between periods for both men and women (actual time), in accordance with UWW rules. The timing displayed on the scoreboards will start from six (6) and go to zero (0) minutes.

The winner is declared by the addition of points at the end of the regular time in both periods. Evident technical superiority of eight (8) points for men's Greco-Roman Wrestling and ten (10) points for men's and women's Freestyle Wrestling automatically leads to victory.

In the event of a fall, the match will be stopped automatically, whatever the period.

COMPETITION VENUE

→ Champs-de-Mars Arena (CDM)

7 Place Joffre - 75007 Paris - France

Designed by the architect Jean-Michel Wilmotte and spanning 10,000 sq m, the Arena's timber structure, with its harmonious curves and aesthetics reflecting the Grand Palais, was set up on the Champ de Mars at the start of 2021, opposite the Ecole Militaire. Aligned with this esplanade, it blends seamlessly into the urban landscape. Thanks to its use of sustainable materials and the building's structure, this project is fully aligned with the environmental standards required by Paris 2024.

Created to host the art, fashion and sports events usually organised in the Nave while the Grand Palais is being renovated, it will also be the stage for cultural events ranging from gastronomy to performing arts.

The competition venue is located 18 kilometres from the Olympic Village and will have a gross capacity of 9,535.

Champs-de-Mars Arena will also host the Judo competition during the Olympic Games and the Wheelchair Rugby and Para Judo during the Paralympic Games.

→ Field of play

The field of play for the Wrestling competitions at Champ de Mars Arena will consist of a raised platform 0.8m high with a sponge-floor surface. On the platform, there will be three (3) octagonal mats located adjacent to one another, each with the dimensions of 12m x 12m and a combat circle 9m in diameter. The competition area and all equipment will be presented in accordance with UWW rules.

→ Facilities

The warm-up area will be in a separate hall near the field of play inside the competition venue and will consist of four (4) square mats. Other facilities at the competition venue will include:

- changing rooms and showers (separate men's/women's)
- lounges for athletes and officials
- catering services
- Internet access in designated areas
- athletes' cubicles
- mixed zones where accredited media interview athletes after competition
- sport information desk
- medical services
- doping control station

TRAINING VENUES

→ General information

Training for Wrestling will take place from 27 July to 10 August at three (3) different training venues: Gymnase Pablo Neruda, Village Studio 3 and Village Studio 7. Gymnase Pablo Neruda has four (4) training mats, Studio 3 has five (5) mats and Studio 7 has three (3) mats.

All training equipment will comply with Rule 50 and Bye-law to Rule 50 of the IOC Olympic Charter.

Training at the training venues will be open from 9:00 to 21:00.

The number of mats and the length of training sessions will be determined by the number of wrestlers per discipline in each team.

Training sessions will be available in 30-minutes slots up to a maximum of two (2) hours (120 minutes). Note that times may change according to training days.

There will be no training on the afternoon of the Opening Ceremony.

Training slot allocation and booking conditions are yet to be determined. Training session slots can be booked and modified at the Sport Information Centre in the Olympic Village or at the Sport Information Desk at the competition venue. Paris 2024 will also put in place an online booking platform.



→ Access to training venues

Only holders of a valid Olympic Identity and Accreditation Card shall have access to the training venues. NOC members will be granted access to one or more training venue(s) according to the sport code(s) received as part of their missions and indicated on their accreditation. Additionally, the IOC has revised the concept of specific passes for training venues.

This access pass will not be used at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, but needs will be incorporated into the “P” accreditation quotas. Note that the maximum quota for “P” accredited coaches per venue is currently being determined with the International Federations. Information shall be sent to NOCs once the quotas have been confirmed.

For access to training venues in the Village, “P” accredited personnel will be allocated an additional dedicated (and not OLV) code granting them access to the training venues in the Olympic Village for a given time period and under strict control.

→ Food and beverage services

No food service will be offered in the training venues, which are located within or near the Olympic Village and therefore near all the catering areas or take-away services. Cold drinks (water and isotonic drinks provided by Coca-Cola) will be available in the Studios.
